

2022 ANNUAL REPORT

MISSION

Community Work Services is guided by the belief that **all** people have value and that supporting individuals with disabilities to actively participate in all aspects of community life results in a more diverse, compassionate and stronger community for everyone. With that as a foundation, the agency works in partnership with employers to make a positive difference in the lives of the people we support by helping them find and keep individually meaningful community jobs.

SERVICES TO CLIENTS

In 2022, Community Work Services completed its 38th year of operation, collaborating with over 89 employers in Dane County to provide community-based employment to 79 adults with developmental disabilities. These employers were from both the public and private sector and included large as well as small businesses and organizations (See Attachment #1.)

The 79 clients served in 2022 display the following disabilities or combinations thereof: mild, moderate, severe and profound cognitive disability; visual impairment; hearing impairment; cerebral palsy; epilepsy; autism; brain injury; mild to severe physical limitations; chronic mental illness; and mild to severe behavioral challenges.

Prior to being served by Community Work Services, these individuals attended Dane County special education programs, sheltered workshops, day activity centers, other community based vocational services programs, or resided in nursing homes and/or institutions.

The following is a breakdown of the level of ongoing support provided to each of the 79 clients who were served:

Level of Support

<u>Continuous On-Site Support</u> was provided to <u>27 clients</u>. This level of support is provided to clients who require a staff person to be on site the entire time they are working. The staff person on site is responsible for providing instruction to clients, quality checking work, coordinating daily activities on site, monitoring client behavior and maintaining positive relationships with clients' supervisors and co-workers.

<u>Daily Contact</u> was provided to <u>31 clients</u>. This level of support is provided to clients who are able to work without direct staff supervision for short periods of time. Daily contact from a staff person may occur anywhere from 1 to 6 times per day. These daily contacts involve providing instruction to clients at key times during their work day, monitoring quality, and communicating with clients' supervisors and co-workers.

Weekly Contact was provided to 11 clients. This level of support is provided to clients who can work without direct staff supervision for one to five days at a time but still require someone to spend time on site and monitor job performance on at least a weekly basis. Weekly contact can occur anywhere from 1 to 4 times per week and involves checking work quality, communicating with clients' supervisors and co-workers, and providing any instruction on site as needed.

Monthly Contact was provided to 10 clients. This level of support is provided to clients who have demonstrated a great deal of independence on the job. Staff visits job sites on a monthly basis to monitor client progress and maintain communication with client, supervisor, and co-workers. During this time, any issues that have surfaced since the last contact can be addressed. If necessary, additional contact time is provided.

Job Retention and Paid Employment

In 2022, Community Work Services had a job retention rate of 98.7%. Community Work Services, Inc. has maintained a job retention rate for its clients of over 95% for the past 29 years (See Attachment #2.) In addition, in 2022, 98.7% of Community Work Services' clients were employed in paid jobs in the community. A listing of each client's job placement(s) is included in Attachment #3.

Fostering Social Relationships

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, fostering social relationships continued to be very challenging. In 2022, with the reality of some employers working remotely, or hybrid models, there were definitely limits to enhancing relationships between clients and their work peers. With that said, there were still opportunities to build relationships within the jobsites, which was apparent among the 10 individuals that began new jobs in 2022. We look forward being able to continue to enhance these relationships and more throughout 2023 as more employers/co-workers return to working in the office full time.

Quality Improvement

In 2022, the agency continued to actively work toward upgrading clients' job placements. As a result, in 2022:

- 8 individuals increased the number of hours worked
- 40 individuals had increased wages
- 7 individuals expanded their job responsibilities
- 5 individuals were placed in new jobs
- 5 individuals were placed in an additional placement to supplement existing position(s)
- individuals received benefits (e.g. health insurance, vacation, paid sick time, retirement benefits, etc...)
